MACUCO BOAT RIDE

Jungle Ride

The tour begins with a Jungle Ride for about 1.5 miles throughout the fantastic lush subtropical rainforest of Iguassu. English-speaking trail guides walk you through the whole experience.

The capacity of the wagon is 24 people. No need reservation on this tour, departures every 10 minutes. Open daily from 09am to 05:30pm. The boat ride is recorded and the footage offered in a DVD or flash drive but this is not included on the ticket, paid separated. You get wet for sure, company does not provide raincoats or cover for cameras or cell phones. There a dry ride option which prevents guests of getting wet.

Hike in the woods

The hike is quite short but with some steps on the way. In case you feel like not doing it, it's not mandatory you can reach the dock by jeeps.





Accessibility

The company has all its fleet adapted to people with special needs, so if you have a wheelchair or people with knee or walking issues, there is a way to make them enjoy the tour without physical challenges.

No steps to the dock

No steps at all to reach the dock! At the dock a lift for wheelchairs. Life jackets are mandatory, provided by the company however raincoats and cover for cameras not, if you decide to take cell phones or cameras you may but you need to protect them with your own equipment.

The Boat Ride

Yeah the boat ride is pretty wet but fun and super safe. The boat drivers know the river as the back of their hands. There is changing rooms so you can change before or after the tour. Lockers are available to store your belongings but in a private tour, our tour guides can be your very own personal lockers. There is a dry boat ride which does not get too close to the falls so guests do not get wet, not so exciting as the traditional wet one.

QUIZ ABOUT THIS TOUR

- Do it when visiting the Brazilian Side of the Falls;
- You have to do it on the same day because You can not go in and out of the National Park;
- If You do not have enough time to do it during you visit to the Brazilian Side You can do the **Great Adventure Boat Ride** which is over the Argentine Side;
- The tour is doable and safe even when it's raining;
- Comparing the **Macuco Boat Ride** to the **Great Adventure Boat Ride** (in Argentina), Macuco is much easier and not physically demanding, besides in Argentina there are different regulations on restrictions about former heart conditions, in ear devices, walking sticks;
- Also the **Great Adventure boat ride** has a lot of steps in and out to the dock, so If You have seniors or people with knee problems it could be an issue;
- Another detail is that in Argentina the company offers few departures per day, so You will have to organize your whole Argentine side prioritizing the departure of the **Great Adventure boat ride**.
